Do you want to demonstrate your skills to a potential employer? Are you planning on pursuing a different career, re-train or gain a Workplace Experience through Experiential Learning?

IF SO, THE SKILLS LAUNCH PROGRAM MAY BE FOR YOU

IN THE SKILLS LAUNCH PROGRAM YOU WILL:

- Learn about various occupations/jobs
- Discover your goals and skills and learn about Work-Life balance
- Get Workplace Safety training (e.g. WHMIS, Emergency First Aid/CPR)
- Complete job search techniques and interview skills
- Learn about the Canadian workplace culture
- Complete a paid work experience/internship

THE PROGRAM WILL:

- Provide an opportunity for you to re-train
- Show an employer your skills and work ethic
- Provide you with local references
- Offer the possibility of full-time employment

PARTICIPANTS MUST:

- Be OVER 30 years old and not attending school
- Not be in receipt of Employment Insurance (EI) benefits
- Be committed to complete the classes, technical training, and employment workshops
- Be available and committed to complete paid employment placement
- Have CLB level 4 completed

- 1 Talk to your employment specialist / settlement counsellor
- 2 Meet with the Adult Employability / Bridging Coordinator to identify suitability and apply
- 3 Complete 8 week *Work Essential Skills* and *Workplace Safety* training
- 4 Complete job search strategies workshop and job-specific test drive
- 5 Complete paid employment placement
